NOTICE is given that the District of Wells Council seeks public input on “Off-Highway Recreational Vehicle Regulation Bylaw, No. 153, 2017”. A Public Consultation Meeting on the proposed Bylaw is scheduled for Tuesday, August 1, 2017 commencing at 7:00 pm in the Wells Municipal Hall – Council Chamber, 4243 Sanders Avenue. The meeting provides an opportunity for the public to speak or submit written comments on the bylaw.

The purpose of “Off-Highway Recreational Vehicle Regulation Bylaw, No. 153, 2017” is to:

- Regulate, govern, or prohibit the operation of all-terrain vehicles within the District of Wells; and
- Regulate the use of all highways and public places within the District of Wells.

Written submissions regarding the proposed bylaw may be submitted to the District of Wells Municipal Office until Friday, July 28, 2017, 12:00 pm for inclusion in the meeting agenda. Written submissions will be read out at the meeting. Oral and written submissions will also be received at the meeting. All written and verbal submissions will become part of the public record.
