

## Wells-Barkerville Community Forest Ltd.

November 24, 2017

This note and the accompanying map are intended to help inform the public of what and where logging activity is taking place in the Wells-Barkerville Community Forest during November 2017 through February 2018; more specifically in the Downey Creek/Cornish/One Mile Road area (see accompanying map).

It is recommended that the public not use the roads and trails in the area where logging machinery and trucks is active.

The recommendation that the public not use the Downey Creek/Cornish/One Mile Road area is based on the following:

- Ski trails in the area are narrow and there will be active logging machinery and logging trucks;
- There are minimal pull-outs on roads for vehicles to pass and the road will be plowed;
- Because of that activity the road will not be suitable for skiing or snowshoeing;
- Harvesting machines are also relatively quiet and operator visibility is limited by limbs and snow which may increase safety concerns;
- Harvesting could be going on 7 days a week in order to complete that work as quickly as possible.
